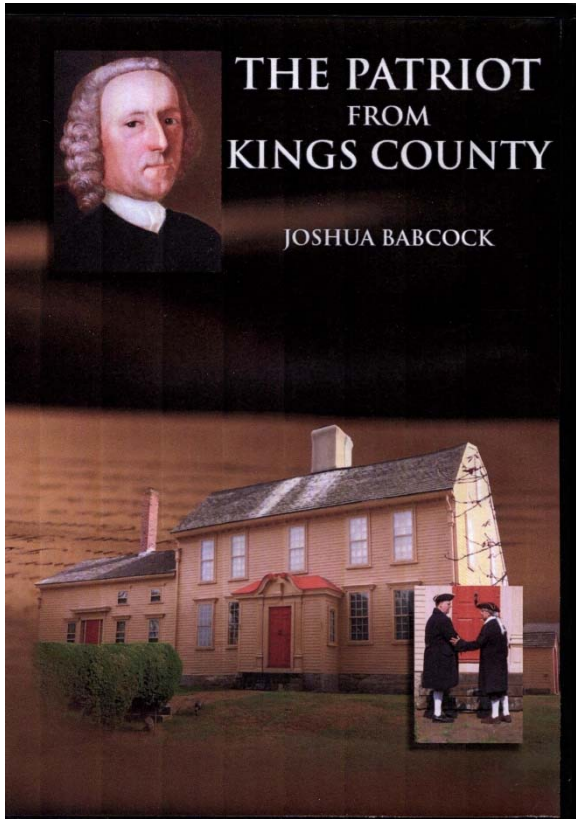

Dr. Babcock was a physician, statesman, judge, postmaster and friend of Benjamin Franklin. He was the grandson of one of the first permanent settlers of Westerly and built his house in 1734 on property on Post Road in Westerly (now known as Granite Street). That house is currently open as a museum, known as Babcock-Smith House Museum.
